

Foreword

Forging a Stronger India and Czech Republic Relationship

India's trade and cultural relations with the Czech Republic have a In the light of this strong India-Czech history of relationship, long history. In the medieval ages, the Kingdom of Bohemia and the Austro-Hungarian Empire traded precious goods including Indian spices with India through marine and land routes. The relations between the two countries have continued to flourish in later centuries with frequent exchanges between academicians, artists, business people and political leaders.

India's relations with the former Czechoslovakia, and with the Czech Republic, have always been warm and friendly. Diplomatic relations with Czechoslovakia were established in 1947 which has smoothly transitioned into a vibrant relationship with the Czech Republic after the peaceful bifurcation of Czechoslovakia in 1993 into Czech Republic and Slovakia. This strengthening of the relationship has been fuelled by trade, regular visits, interactions and exchanges between prominent Indian and Czech scholars, journalists, politicians, business people and artists.

it has been a privilege for me to be assigned the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of India to the Czech Republic in 2018, providing me the opportunity to steer this relationship to greater heights. The visit by the President of India to the Czech Republic took place after a gap of 22 years and the visit of the Czech Prime Minister to India happened after a gap of 12 years.

As we celebrate 75 years of bilateral relations, this publication brings out some of the key moments of my tenure in the Czech Republic which I share with you as I look back fondly.



















Visit of Hon'ble Prime Minister of the Czech Republic to India

Indická velvyslankyně si Prahu zamilovala

Získali jsme pozvání z ambasády Indické republiky v České republice. Naší hostitelkou byla sama indická velvyslankyně Narinder Chauhan. Během rozhovoru jsme se dozvěděli, co společného mají indický a český státní znak, čím ji potěšili čeští studenti během návštěvy indického prezidenta v Praze nebo jaké destinace v Indii by doporučila našim turistům.



V Indii žije přes 1,3 miliardy lidí, je to druhá nejlidnatější země světa a co do rozlohy sedmá největší. Kousek indického území však najdete i v Praze. Pochopitelně jde o indickou ambasádu se sídlem v pražské ulici Milady Horákové. Do areálu Pražského hradu je to odtud patnáct minut chůze, na Staroměstské náměstí dvacet.

"Mám velké štěstí, že si mohu prohlížet pražské památky. Během vánočních trhů jsem denně chodila na Staré Město, dokonce i když byla zima a pršelo," usmívá se velvyslankyně Narinder Chauhan, která pracovně procestovala bez nadsázky celý svět: působila v Japonsku, Kanadě, Belgii, Thajsku i Srbsku. Na stůl od indické hostitelky dostávám čaj a také barfi, tradiční sladkosti z mléka a cizrnové mouky. Můžeme začít.

Paní velvyslankyně, máte v kanceláři něco osobního, co si berete vždy s sebou?

Vždy musím mít v kanceláři fotografii Mahátmy Gándhího, otce mého národa. Jeho narozeniny se slaví po celém světě, 2. říjen, datum Gándhího narození, je totiž zároveň Mezinárodním dnem nenásilí. Letos oslavíme 150 let od jeho narození a k tomuto výročí se budou vydávat památeční známky, a to nejen v Indii, ale i v České republice.

Je ještě něco dalšího, podobně cenného?

Důležitá je pro mě také indická vlajka a její symbolika: bílá barva značí mír, ta zelená zemědělství a prosperitu a oranžová oběť našich zakladatelů (Indie získala nezávislost na Velké Británii v roce 1947, pozn. red.). Ve středu vlajky můžete vidět dharma čakru (ta reprezentuje pravdu, zákon – pozn. red.). Dharma čakru mimochodem najdete také na indickém státním znaku, kde je

Prozraďte prosím čtenářům, jak jste se dostala k diplomacii a následně do Česka.

Narodila jsem se v Novém Dillí, hlavním městě Indické republiky. Po studiích práva a politických věd na tamní univerzitě jsem nastoupila do diplomatických služeb. Každý nový pracovník v diplomacii se musí povinně naučit jeden cizí jazyk, mně připadla japonština. Po roce tréninku jsem pak byla vyslána přímo do Tokia, kde jsem tři roky pracovala na indické ambasádě. V další kariéře jsem působila například v thajském Bangkoku, belgickém Bruselu či kanadské Ottawě.

A jako velvyslankyně?


V pozici veľvyslankyně jsem poprvé pracovala v Srbsku, kde se mojí kamarádkou stala veľvyslankyně České republiky v Srbsku Ivana Hlavsová. Vždy když jsem potřebovala s něčím pomoci, mohla jsem se obrátit na ni. V červenci loňského roku jsem pak nastoupila na ambasádu v České republice. V září měl Česko navštívit náš prezident, Jeho Excelence Rám Náth Kóvind. Byla to historická událost, protože poslední taková návštěva se konala před 22 lety, a vše se muselo řádně připravit.

Co se vám tehdy vybavilo pod pojmem Česká republika?

Například české sklo. Vlastně mi přijde, že je ve světě známější než v České republice. Díky Ivaně Hlavsové jsem si kupovala český křištál, ještě když jsem pracovala v Srbsku. A když jsem tu pak začala působit, vůbec jsem podobné věci neviděla v obchodech. Samozřejmě jsem také znala české značky jako Škoda Auto. V Indii dnes působí okolo šedesáti českých značek a mimochodem právě Škoda Auto se chystá v Indii investovat miliardu eur. Auta bude v naší zemi nejen vyrábět, ale také vyvíjet. Až se vrátím do Indie, ráda bych si jeden vůz značky Škoda koupíla.

Je ještě něco, co vás v Praze zaujalo?


Když teď v Praze žiji, užívám si například náplavku s výhledem na Pražský hrad. Byla jsem na koncertech v Rudolfinu, na představeních v Národním divadle. Samozřejmě jsem také chodila na vánoční trhy, myslím, že ty v Praze jsou nejkrásnější na světě. A všechny ty historické budovy, které máte... Musíte být hrdí.
